The ranking of the top fifty companies are judged primarily on a weighted-average computation of a set of performance indicators over a three-year period, such as:

- Operating Profit Before Tax (OPBT)
- Gross Turnover
- Return on Equity
- Growth in Operating Profits
- Growth in Turnover
- Net Tangible Assets
- Operating Cash Flow as a percentage of OPBT
- Quick Ratio
- Debt to Equity Ratio
- Return on Total Fixed Assets
- Operating Profit per Employee



In addition, qualitative factors such as business model, productivity and innovation, management ideals and governance, knowledge initiatives, market branding and presence, and liquidity and risk management are also evaluated and taken into consideration in the ranking process of the companies.
